Evidence-based psychological therapies: from bench to bedside

Abstract

Patients with mental health difficulties do not always receive appropriate and recommended psychological treatment for their difficulties, and directors are not always appropriately trained to deliver them. This paper considers why this might be the case and provides an overview of the Charlie Waller Institute, a notifor-profit organisation funded by the NHS. University of Reading, and the Charlie Waller Memorial Trust. The institute seeds to address this problem by training directors in wide variety of evidence-based therapies and assessing the impact of this training on director knowledge and skill.

Key points

- Psychological therapy (and cognitive behavioural therapy in paticular) has been shown to be effective for a variety of mental health difficulties.
- Patents typically do not receive any psychological treatment for their difficulties, and if
 they do, treatment may be without scientific support or delivered suboptimisty
- One reason for such inappropriate/suboptimel thempy is that dinicians are often not trained to deliver the treatments with empirical support i.e. those recommended by the National Institute for Health and Clinical Excellence (NICE)
- The Charle Waller Institute of Evidence Based Psychological Treatment seeks to address
 this issue by providing training programmes led by the world leaders in a wide variety
 of therapies recommended by NCE evidence suggests that this approach enhances
 dinicians "knowledge and skills."

sychological treatments have come a long way since the development of effective treatments for the neuroses. The National Institute for Health and Clinical Excellence (NICE) draw on data from randomised controlled trials: and based on these analyses produces guidelines that recommend a broad range of psychological therapies for a range of mental health disorders. For example, for depression, the NICE guideline lists in terpe monal therapy, be havioural activation. counselling and cognitive behavioural therapy (CBT) as recommended treatments (NICE, 2000a). Furthermore, family therapy and CBT are interventions with a sound evidence base for paychotic problems (NICE, 2009b). Across the anxiety disorders. CBT has been shown to alleviate anxious symptomatology and is recommended by NICE. Systematic analyses have shown that

CBT pood uces effects sizes ranging from 2.57 to 0.14 for a range of psychological disorders (Clark et al. 2005; Butler et al. 2005; Hofman and Smits, 2008; Wykes et al. 2008). Similarly, there are efficacious psychological the apies for bulimia nervosa (Agras, et al. 2000) and binge eating disorder (Wilson et al. 2000). Family therapy for all olescents with amoresia nervosa is also producing very strong outcomes with patients showing a significant reduction in eating disorder symptomatology both directly after treatment and at six-month follow-up (Lock et al. 2005).

Not only are these psychological treatments available, they can now be delivered in a range of formats and settings, often without sacrificing their impact. CBTd elivered by computer for depression has been shown in meta-analyses. to have a positive outcome on both decressive and anxious symptomatology (Spek et al., 2007). Telemed icine for bulimia nervosa (in which CBT is delivered by a therapist remotely) has been shown in a randomised controlled trial to be both acceptable to patients and roughly equivalent in outcome to therapy delivered in person (Mitchell et al, 2005). Self-help books also have a positive impact. For example, a recent systematic review of its meta-amalyses conducted by Van't Hof et al. (2009) found that self-help methods show effect sizes as large those in a range of anxiety disorders. and depression, comparable to effect sizes seen for face to face treatments.

There is also a growing evidence base indicating that short forms of psychological treatments are also efficacious. Studies show that six sessions of treatment for post-traumatic stress discorder (PTSD) are sufficient to lead to recovery for 70% of patients (Ehlers et al., 2010) and a course of treatment contisting of six hours of CET has been shown to help 70% of patients with panic disorder recover, with 70% of patients being panic-free at 12-month follow-up (Clark et al., 1999). This indicates that a number of patients who did not reach clinical improvement criteria at post-treatment did so at follow-up. Furthermore, studies have shown that there is no difference between the efficacy of brief and intensive CBT
